

## Village Club Horse Use

Village Club owned horses are for the primary use of the schooling program and to introduce members to horsemanship. There is a \$35.00 per hour charge for school horse use. Members not enrolled in a lesson may use a Village Club owned horse under the following conditions:

- A. The rider must have proven experience and ability to ride unsupervised.
- B. Permission must be obtained from either the Village Club instructor or the Club Manager for each ride.
- C. The rider must complete liability release and emergency contact forms and must be at least 6 years old.
- D. Use must be recorded on the school horse sign-up sheet located in manager's office.
- E. Use is limited to two hours.
- F. Guests of members may use a VC owned horse under the conditions outlined above. The member must be present and supervising the guest during the entire contact with the horse. The charge is \$50.00 per hour.
- G. Each VC owned horse has its own tack and grooming equipment located in the school shed. For the health and safety of both horse and rider, please use the appropriate equipment.
